- 1. Things to check **if you are on an Ara campus** using your own personal device:
 - a. Are you logged in to Ara wifi and not Ara Guest?
 - b. Have you cleared your browsing data? (Use the Ctrl Shift Delete keys as a short cut on a PC or Command Shift Delete keys on a Mac).
- 2 Begin at My Ara: <u>https://myara.ara.ac.nz/</u>
- 3 Click on the Library Search tile.



4. Type in your search terms and click on **EBooks and more** to action the search e.g.

project management	×	Ļ	Q
project management p Everything			
project management ρ Books, eBooks & more			
project management p Journal articles			
project management P EBooks and more			

Note: You can also enter your search terms by clicking the microphone icon

5. Under your chosen title click on Available online.



6. Click on Available online under a book record.



7. Under View Online click on the link under Full text availability

e.g. ProQuest Ebook Central in the example below:

8. Use your student username and password to log in if you are prompted.

Download a chapter in your ebook to print out as a PDF

9. Click "**Download PDF Chapter**" (Note : In this example you can download up to 77 pages under copyright conditions for this title.)



10. Navigate to the chapter you wish to download and click on **Download PDF**

(Note: In this example I have downloaded 14 of the 77 page limit I am allowed to download, so I can still download another 63 pages.)



11. Click on Check out Ebook.

12. Click on **Download** and **print** your chapter (PDF).
