

# Accessing The Practising Midwife

1. In **Edge** open a **NewInPrivate** window via three dots in top right corner of your browser.
2. Go to the [Midwifery Subject Guide/Articles-Databases](#) page and click on **Practising Midwife** in the **Midwifery Journals** section.
3. Scroll to the bottom of the page and look for the sentence “Please use our [simple search](#) if your facility restricts use of the advanced search field above” and click on **Simple Search** within that sentence.
4. In **Simple Search** type in your keywords e.g. Cultural safety in New Zealand



5. Click **Search**
