



## Find journal articles using Library Search

- 1. Begin at My Ara: <a href="https://myara.ara.ac.nz/">https://myara.ara.ac.nz/</a>
- 2 Click on Library Search tile.




3. If you find an article from a non-Ara internet source e.g. Semantic Scholar or Pubmed and it is not in full text, use these instructions to see if Ara has access via a subscribed source.

Sample journal article title:

Asher, J.B.(2008). The Cartwright report twenty years on. Nursing New Zealand, 14(7), 2.

4. Type the journal article title into the **Search box** and use the drop down to select **Journal articles** 

e.g.



5. Press **Enter** on your keyboard or click on the **Search button** 





6. If the title appears in your results then click on "Available Online" below the title to see which databases hold this title.



7. Under View online click on the database name e.g. CINAHL Ultimate



- 8. If prompted, use your **student email** and **password** to login.
- 9. You should be taken directly to the database to gain access to the full text of the article you searched for.
- 10. Note 1: If the article did not open, then directly access the database indicated in Library Search via <u>A-Z Databases</u> on the Library homepage and do a search for the article title within that database.
- 11. Note 2: You can do the same search to find which databases might hold information on your topic. If you do this, then remember to tick **peer-reviewed** and limit your search by **publication date** if these aspects are important in your results.
