

Connecting to Ara WiFi- Android Devices

Please Note: You will need to have activated your student account by signing into a physical PC on Campus to be able to sign into the Ara Wifi.

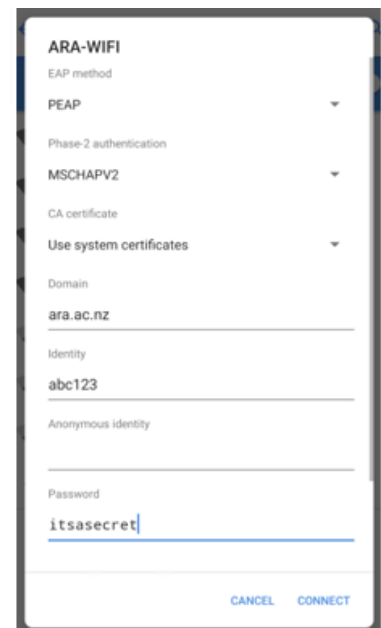
Wifi Connector App

For Android devices, there is an application available for download which allows you to simply enter your network username and password to connect to the Ara Wifi.

1. Open the Google Play Store, and search for **Ara Wifi Connector**.
2. Ensure that Ara Institute of Canterbury is listed as the author, Click **Install**.
3. Open the application and enter your Network Username and Password, then click **Configure**.
4. The application will close and connect the device to the Ara-Wifi.

Manual Setup

1. On your android device go to settings and wireless networks.
Make sure Wi-Fi is turned on.
2. Go to Wi-Fi Settings.
3. Tap to connect to the ARA-WIFI network.
4. On the connection screen that opens you will need to make sure Android has the following settings:
 - EAP Method is **PEAP**.
 - Phase-2 authentication is **MSCHAPv2**.
 - **Identity** is your everyday Moodle/Network username.
 - **Password** is your everyday Moodle/Network password.
 - Use system certificates and set Domain to ara.ac.nz.
 - Do not set anything in the Anonymous Identity field.
 - Choose **Connect** to complete wifi set up.



Once completed you will be connected to the Internet and will receive no further prompts now or in the future unless your password changes.
